## Colson Asks Postponement Of Action to Disbar Him

RICHMOND, Aug. 5 (AP)—Charles W. Colson, the imprisoned former special counsel to President Nixon, asked the Virginia Supreme Court today t postpone any action on a metition seeking his disbarment.

Mr. Colson, in a response filed by Theodore J. Markow, a Richmond lawyer asked that action on the petition be pu aside until he is out of prison and can personally defend himself against disbarment action taken recently by the Virginia State Bar.

Mr. Markow said that since Mr. Colson was not practicing law, there was no urgency for the requested disciplinary a tion. Mr. Colson was sentenced

tion. Mr. Colson was sentenced in June to a one-to-three year Federal prison term after plead-ing guilty to obstruction of jus-tice in connection with the Pentagon papers trial of Daniel Ellsberg.
