

Congress Gets Same Rating As Nixon in Harris Survey

While Congress and President Nixon grapple over the impeachment issue, Louis Harris, the poll taker, says that Americans interviewed in a poll give them both an equally low rating of 29 per cent.

Mr. Harris said Monday, The Associated Press reported, "By any standard, both the President and Congress are presently held in low esteem by the American people."

However, in the nationwide survey of 1,447 adults taken July 17-21, Congress rebounded from its record low mark of 21 per cent registered in a poll last January.

The new results show 29 per cent of those polled gave Congress a rating of excellent, 64 per cent fair or poor and 7 per cent unsure.
