Gerald Ford does not spend much time patting himself on the back. In fact, one of his foremost virtues is an awareness of his own limits.

"I have made some mistakes and will probably make some more," he told the House Judi-

ciary Committee. "I hope I never get to the point where I cannot admit I have been wrong."
