A prominent member of the local Republican party here said yesterday he expects President Nixon to sell his San Clemente residence because "the people of California don't want him."

Farrell Smith, a member of the San Clemente Republican Club and once a staunch Nixon supporter, said the feeling in the community surrounding the Nixon home is "that people

don't think he's such a great man now."

Smith, a candidate for city council, said many residents feel Mr. Nixon will sell the seaside estate, which he purchased in 1969, and move to his residence in Key Biscayne, Fla.

"The people of California don't want him and he's too vain to stay where he isn't wanted," Smith said.
