## Six Years A

## Washington

President Nixon's televised address to the nation last night marked the sixth anniversary of the night he triumphantly accepted the Republican party's nomination for his first term in the White House.

In his acceptance speech the night of Aug. 8, 1968, at the GOP national convention in Miami Beach, Mr. Nixon promised "A new day for America, a new dawn for peace and freedom in the world."

He also charged that

"America's in trouble today, not because her people have failed but because her leaders have failed."
