

Republican Telethon Postponed

A Republican party telethon, scheduled to have been broadcast from Los Angeles last night, was postponed yesterday morning.

A spokesman for Republican National Chairman George Bush in Los Angeles quoted Bush as saying:

"The fast-changing situation in Washington has made it uncertain that party leaders could come to Los Angeles to appear on the program."

Vice President Gerald Ford was scheduled to be the star attraction of the 90-minute show, which was to have been seen on ABC stations in California, Oregon and Washington.

Ford yesterday morning canceled his flight to Los Angeles when he was called into conference by President Nixon.

Bush emphasized that "this is a postponement, not a cancelation. We have a program we believe in and we will present it in the very near future."
