House in Nixon Area In Florida Up for Sale

MIAMI, Sept. 7 (UPI)—One of five houses in the Key Biscayne Presidential compound went on sale Saturday at a price of \$400,000.

The house was used for communications and office space for aides to Richard M. Nixon when he was President.

Jerry Clark, a Key Biscayne realtor, said he had been authorized to put the house and lot on the market. It is owned by a trust fund group set up under Edward Campbell, with Edwin H. Underwood, a lawyer, listed as the owner of record.

Speculators said two other Nixon houses in the compound may go up for sale or lease soon, now that Mr. Nixon has settled into his home at San Clemente, Calif.
