**Nixon's 1962 Conqueror  
Discerns Boon for Nation**

SACRAMENTO, Calif., Aug. 8 (UPI)—Former Gov. Edmund G. Brown of California, a Democrat, said today the resignation of President Nixon would be good for the country. Mr. Brown, the only living person to defeat Mr. Nixon in a race for political office, over-

powered his Republican challenger by 296,758 votes in 1962 for the California governorship. "It is good for the country," Mr. Brown said today. "I just feel that this is the best thing that could happen." Many observers believed in 1962 that Mr. Brown had ended Mr. Nixon's political career. Today Mr. Brown said, "It is a tragic end to a career I thought I had terminated in 1962. That is the way life goes."
