Liberties Union called today for the impeachment
of Richard M. Nixon even
though he has resigned as
President of the United

President of the United States.

Chairman Edward J. Ennis said there was a 98-year-old legal precedent for impeaching a mareven after he left office. He said in a stateme that the Senate ruled in 1876 that resignation did not preclude impeachment proceedings. It ruled against former Secretary of War William W. Belknap who argued that his resignation barred impeachment proceedings.

Belknap was impeached and acquitted.
