Some Stay With Nixon

SAN CLEMENTE, Calif., Aug. 9 (UPI)—Stephen Bull, appointments secretary to Richard Nixon in the White House, said today that he and other members of the staff who came here from Washington plan to stay on "at long as we are wanted or needed."

Bull and press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler accompanied the Nixon family on the flight to California along with several other staff members, including Col. Jack Brennan, a military

aided. Under law, Mr. Nixon receives an allowance for maintaining some staff members.

Bull talked briefly with reporters at the San Clemente Inn near the Nixon residence.

"We are going to remain on as long as we are wanted or needed," Bull said. "No one is talking about long-term stuff yet. We're not even trying to figure out the answers yet. We'll try to figure out the questions first."
