from the United States Secret Service.

Agents are assigned to them around the clock wherever they may live or travel. The agency does not disclose the number of agents protecting them at any given time. Usually two agents accompany thhem on travels and sometimes these are aug-

mented as needed by agents assigned to specific locations.

The Nixons' two married daughters, Mrs. David Eisenhower and Mrs. Edward F. Cox, are not given such protection. Only minor children, for example, the children of Mrs. Aristotle Onassis, the widow of President Kennedy, are eligible.

No figures are available on the cost of the protection for former Presidents and their families.
