

In New York, a well-known literary agent says conversations were held a month ago about publication of Mr. Nixon's memoirs, with the asking price reportedly a minimum of two million dollars. Publishing circles, though, expressed doubt the writings could command that figure because of uncertainty about whether Mr. Nixon would tell the truth about Watergate without some kind of immunity being granted.
