In a telephone survey of 550 American voters, 55 per cent felt that an investigation of possible criminal charges against for mer President Nixon should be dropped. Thirty seven per cent felt that such an investigation should continue.

Seventy-nine per cent of those surveyed believe Mr. Nixon did the right thing by resigning, acording to the poll conducted for Newsweek magazine by the Gallup Organiza tion.
Only 13 per cent of those polled believe Mr. Nixon should have re mained in office. The poll was conducted immedi ately after the resignation announcement Thursday evening.
