The home where Pat Nixon grew up was firebombed early yesterday.

Authorities said a bottle filled with gasoline was thrown against the house in

nearby Cerritos and the flames spread inside. Damage was estimated at \$2000.

The home is part of Patricia Nixon Historical Park.

The City of Cerritos owns the home, which is preserved as a historical monument

Mrs. Nixon was born in Ely, Nev., in 1912, but her family moved here the following year when her father took up forming in neighbor. took up farming in neighboring Artesia.

Deputies are investigating

the incident.
