## **SFChronicle Financier Smith Cleared On Contempt Charges**

## San Diego

Financier C. Arnholt Smith, long-time friend and campaign contributor to former President Richard Nixon, will not have to serve time in jail for contempt for refusing to testify in a criminal trial.

California's Fourth Dis-trict Court of Appeal has an-nulled the indefinite jail term Superior Court Judge Paul<sub>C</sub>E. Overton imposed on Smith June 14.

Smith was called to testify in the trial of Robert Dag-

gett, 49, who was accused of trying to extort money from him.

"Any answers Smith might give might be used against him," his attorney argued.

That grand jury later in-dicted Smith on charges that include conspiracy, misap-plication of funds of a na-tional bank, making false statements to bank officers and making false entries in books of a national bank.
