

Waldie for Indictment Of Nixon

Congressman Jerome R. Waldie said yesterday he regarded it as "self-evident that Richard Nixon should be indicted."

"I think Richard Nixon should be held accountable to the courts of our land the same as any other person," declared the Antioch Democrat, a member of the House Judiciary Committee

"I do not like to see unnecessary suffering, but the lesson of Watergate will have its impact reduced if the evidence against Richard Nixon is not presented to the grand jury."

Waldie told reporters here that he objected to administration proposals to give Mr. Nixon \$850,000 to cover his "transitional" period in leaving the White House and returning to private life. He said he suspected much of the money would be used by Mr. Nixon in preparing his legal defense against possible criminal charges.
