N.Y. Curriculum NEW YORK, Sept. 4 (AP)—New York City's 1.1 million public school pub-pils will study a new sub-ject this fall—Watergate. "The subject of Water-gate and its long-term im-plications for students and the country will become a regular part of the social studies curriculum in all city schools starting this academic year," said school Chancellor Irving Anker.

He said he will order the subject introduced on all levels—elementary, junior and senior high school—and direct schools to hold "frank and open" lessons on the subject. "The basic responsibil-ity of schools is to train Students for citizenship, and we're obviously going to have to do something to avoid cynicism of young people toward their gov-ernment as a result of the scandal," he said.
