Opinion Poll Was Against

Nixon Pardon

New York

A survey conducted for Newsweek magazine just three days before President Ford granted Richard Nixon a pardon indicated that 58 per cent of those polled were opposed to granting amnesty to the former President.

The telephone sampling taken by the Gallup organization showed that only 33 per cent of those polled favored granting Mr. Nixon immunity from prosecution. Nine per cent were undecided.
