Nixon Secluded

At San Clemente

Former President Nixon yesterday remained secluded in his San Clemente home, under orders from his doctor to take medication for a painful and potentially serious blood clot in his leg.

His aides issued no medical bulletins. His former White House physician, Air Force Maj. Gen. Walter Tkach, returned to Washington Friday night after examining Mr. Nixon. SEP

Tkach and Dr. John Lungred of Long Beach, who had treated Mr. Nixon before he was President, said they seriously considered hospitalizing Mr. Nixon to treat a recurrence of phlebitis, but didn't when the former President objected.
