

Million Is Estimate Now for Nixon's
Transition**FOR NIXON'S TRANSITION**

WASHINGTON, Sept. 16 (AP)—The Government estimated today that it would cost more than \$1-million instead of \$850,000 to complete former President Richard M. Nixon's transition to private life in six months rather than eleven.

Arthur F. Sampson, the General Services Administrator, said the speed-up would cost an extra \$233,800, mainly for additional salaries, overtime and rented equipment. Mr. Sampson gave the estimate to Senator Joseph M. Montoya, Democrat of New Mexico, who questioned the legality at hearings last week of taking more than the six months prescribed in the Presidential Transition Act of 1963.
