

Rabbi Korff, who led the campaign to keep former President Nixon in office, today announced the formation of an international Nixon Justice Fund, to raise money to pay for Nixon's legal expenses. According to Korff, Nixon has already spent \$40,000 on auditing his income tax documents and he is expected to spend another \$50,000 on further legal expenses.

Korff, who is in Jerusalem for the Jewish New Year, said he talked to Nixon by telephone last week, and Nixon said it was hard for him to accept Ford's pardon. Korff said Nixon told him, "The only difficulty is for an innocent man to accept a pardon."
