

NIXON READY TO GO

INTO HOSPITAL TODAY

SAN CLEMENTE, Calif., Sept.

22 (UPI)—Former President Richard M. Nixon spent a quiet day today on the eve of his hospitalization for tests and treatment of his worsening phlebitis.

A 10-room section was sealed off on the six floor of Long Beach Memorial Hospital, two for use by Mr. Nixon and his family and the rest for the Secret Service and other use.

Dr. John Lungren, former chief of staff at the hospital, is in charge of the case. He is scheduled to hold a news conference tomorrow morning shortly after Mr. Nixon enters the hospital. He will also issue daily medical bulletins.
