

Security Zone Cut at Nixon Florida Home

The security zone on Biscayne Bay in front of former President Richard M. Nixon's Key Biscayne compound was reduced by 75 per cent yesterday, the Coast Guard said.

The new restricted area will still be patrolled by

Coast Guard vessels.

The area fronting Mr. Nixon's Key Biscayne compound was closed to local boat traffic after he was elected president in 1968. Local fishermen grumbled that the security measures cut them off from some of the best sea trout fishing flats in Biscayne Bay.
