President Ford requested and received a 24-hour extension from a House subcommittee yesterday on its demand for detailed infor-mation on his pardon of for-mer President Nixon. A spokesman for Repre-sentative William L. Hun-gate (Dem-Mo.) chairman of the House judiciary subcommittee studying the pardon, said presidential counsel John O. Marsh Jr. called Hungate Wednesday night and asked for the extension.

The aide added that Marsh indicated he preferred an extension until next Monday, but that Hun-gate could not resist pres-sure from other members and granted 2 days only until this evening.
