Nixon's Clot

Is Dissolving

The blood clot in former President Nixon's right lung has been partially dissolved, his doctor reported yesterday, and there is "no evidence of any additional fresh emboli in the lungs."

Dr. John C. Lungren, who on Monday said Mr. Nixon probably will remain in Memorial Hospital Medical Center here for another week of testing, issued the statement on the basis of a new lung scan.

He said analysis of the new scan and one made when the former President entered the hospital indicated the clot probably moved from his infected left leg to his lung about two weeks before the hospitalization more than a week ago.
