

Reinecke Files Appeal Notice On Conviction

Former California Lieutenant Governor Ed Reinecke, who resigned last week before he was sentenced for violating federal perjury laws, moved to appeal his conviction yesterday.

Reinecke was sentenced October 2 to an 18-month suspended jail term. He filed his notice of appeal in the U.S. Court of Appeals in Washington.

He was accused of lying to the Senate judiciary committee about the date in 1971 when he first told then Attorney General John N. Mitchell about an International Telephone and Telegraph Corp. offer to back the Republican national convention in San Diego.
