## Buzhardt and Buchanan Leaving White House

The resignations of two mainstays of the White House staff of Richard M. Nixon have been accepted by President Ford, it was announced yesterday. Fred Buzhardt, who as legal counsel to the former President fashioned Mr. Nixon's legal fight to stave off impeachment, left his post on Oct. 5 Patrick J. Buchanan, a public-relations adviser and speechwriter who helped fashion the Administration's attacks on news-gathering organizations, has resigned effective Nov. 15, said Ron Nessen, the White House press secretary. Mr. Nessen said he did not know the future plans of Mr. Buzhardt and Mr. Buchanan, who had been asked by Mr. Ford to stay on at the White House during the period of transition.
