

Haig Recalled To Active Duty With the Army

Washington

General Alexander M. Haig was called back to active duty in the Army yesterday, the Pentagon announced.

The former chief of staff to Presidents Ford and Nixon was restored to the basic pay of a four-star general, \$36,000 a year, plus other allowances.

Haig will take over about November 1 as commander of all U.S. forces in Europe and about December 15 as commander of all NATO troops.
