ACLU v. Nixon

- 1. Halperin v. Kissinger. The former National Security Council official is suing Nixon Administration officials for illegally wiretapping his home telephone for 21 months. Nixon has been added as a defendant.
- 2. Hellman v. Sampson. Lillian Hellman, the writer, and others are suing Arthur Sampson of the General Services Administration for access to 147 Nixon tape recordings originally subpoenaed by the House Judiciary Committee but never delivered. Nixon is a defendant.
- 3. Sparrow v. Goodman. Fourteen residents of Charlotte, North Carolina, are suing H.R. Haldeman and others for illegally preventing them from attending the Billy Graham Day rally in October, 1971. Nixon has been subpoenaed for his testimony.
