

Ziegler May Quit As Nixon Aide

LONG BEACH, Calif., Nov. 6 (AP)—Ronald L. Ziegler is thinking of quitting as chief aide to former President Nixon but says he won't leave "until I am sure that a transition is in order."

Ziegler, the former President's press secretary who accompanied his boss to California on Mr. Nixon's resignation, commented to reporters on reports from Washington that he planned to quit next February. He earns \$42,500 a year on Mr. Nixon's payroll.
