Contractor Is Fined \$1,000

For Gift to Nixon Campaign

WASHINGTON, Dec. 3—The former president of an electrical contracting company pleaded guilty today to making an illegal corporate contribution of \$5,000 to President Nixon's 1972 re-election campaign and was fined \$1,000.

The Watergate special prosecution force brought the charge against Charles N. Huseman, of Washington, in a criminal information filed today with Chief Judge George L. Hart Jr. of United States District Court.

The contribution was made May 19, 1972, when Mr. Huseman was president of HMS Electrical Corporation. The contracting company has since been purchased by another company.

"I did this thing, and I realize I was wrong," Mr. Huseman told Judge Hart, who imposed the fine. The charge is a misdemeanor.
