Contractor Is Fined \$1,000 For Gift to Nixon Campaign

WASHINGTON, Dec. 3—The former president of an electrical contracting company pleaded guilty Tuesday to making an illegal corporate contribution of \$5,000 to President Nixon's 1972 re-election campaign and was fined \$1,000.

The Watergate special prosecution force brought the charges against Charles N. Huseman, of Washington, in a criminal information filed Tuesday with Chief Judge George L. Hart Jr. of United States District Court. The contribution was made May 19, 1972, when Mr. Huseman was president of HMS Electrical Corporation. The contracting company has since been purchased by another company.
