WASHINGTON, Dec. 4 (AP)—Former President Richard M. Nixon has been unable to obtain "thousands of lettersr" se to him at the White House in response to a public appeal from a committee backing him, Rabbi Baruch Korff, chairman of the group, charged today.

In the waning days of the Nixon Presidency, Rabbi Korff formed a group that is now trustee of the President Nixon Justice Fund, set up to help pay Mr. Nixon's legal and medical expenses.

"We urged our followersr to write Nixon," Rabbi Korff said, "and obviously thousands and thousands of letters of support arrived after the ninth of August," when Mr. Nixon resigned, A White House spolesman had no immediate comment on the charge.
