Korff Accuses White House
Of Holding Letters to Nixon

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4 (AP)—
Former President Richard M.
Nixon has been unable to ob-
tain "thousands of letters" se-
to him at the White House in
response to a public appeal
from a committee backing him,
Rabbi Baruch Korff, chairman
of the group, charged today.

In the waning days of the
Nixon Presidency, Rabbi Korff
formed a group that is now
trustee of the President Nixon
Justice Fund, set up to help pay
Mr. Nixon's legal and medical
expenses.

"We urged our followers to
write Nixon," Rabbi Korff said,
"and obviously thousands and
thousands of letters of support
arrived after the ninth of Au-
gust," when Mr. Nixon re-
signed. A White House spokes-
man had no immediate com-
ment on the charge.
