Appeal by Liddy In Watergate To Highest Court

G. Gordon Liddy appealed his conviction on conspiracy, burglary and wiretap charges in the Watergate break-in to the U.S. Supreme Court yesterday.

Liddy asked the court to review a November 8 decision of the U.S. Court of Appeals here upholding his conviction.

He was found guilty by a jury in U.S. District Court and was sentenced to from six years to 20 years in prison and fined \$40,000.

Liddy was general counsel to the Committee for the Reelection of the President in Richard Nixon's 1972 presidential campaign.
