Rebozo's Bank on Key Biscayne Robbed

Key Biscayne, Fla.

C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo's Key Biscayne bank and Trust Co. was robbed yesterday of an undetermined amount of cash by a drive-in bandit in a foreign car who got off the island before police could seal it off.

Police said the man handed a note to a drive-in teller at the island bank demanding she fill a sack with money, and warning, "there is a

man inside the bank with a bomb."

Bank Vice President David L. Woods said the teller "handed over a small amount of money and the man drove off."

Police searched the bank, but found no bomb.

Dade county sheriff's deputies ordered the drawbridge raised on the Rickenbacker causeway—the only highway link from the Mi-

ami mainland to the island, where former President Nixon had a vacation compound.

Police and marine patrol boats were called out in case the suspect attempted to flee by boat. The sheriff's helicopter also searched the island.

But two hours after the robbery, sheriff's sergeant Doug Taggerty said the bandit "apparently escaped."
