NEW YORK, Jan. 6 (UPI) Jack L. Chestnut, a Minneap lis lawyer who managed Se Hubert H. Humphrey's 19 senatorial campaign, plead innocent today to a charge arranging an illegal campai d contribution that year from milk producer.

Chestnut, 42, who also ma aged Humphrey's 1972 pres dential campaign, was accuse in a one-count indictment file last month of arranging a \$12 000 contribution from Assoc ated Milk Producers, Inc., Kansas-based firm.

The count charges Chestmattempted to conceal the coporate contribution by makin it payable to a now-defunder New York advertising firmulation which was handling publicited for Humphrey.

Chestnut's plea was made before U.S. District Counding Thomas Griesa in Manattan. No date was set for hearing. If convicted, Ches nut faces a maximum penalt of two years in prison and fine of \$10,000.
