Liddy Resumes His Prison Term Tomorrow

G. Gordon Liddy, who directed the Watergate burglary team, will resume his interrupted prison sentence tomorrow after three months of freedom.

Liddy, sentenced to a term of six years and eight months to 20 years after trial in 1973, was freed last October 15 while the U.S. Court of Appeals considered his case.

The appeals court turned him down and last week the U.S. Supreme Court refused to allow him to remain free while his appeal goes higher.

Chief U.S. District Judge George L. Hart Jr. formalized Liddy's return date yesterday.
