Army Ride Alleged For Haig Poodle

The supreme commander of NATO, Gen. Alexander M. Haig Jr., illegally ordered a U.S. Army staff car to give his French poodle, Duncan, a special ride in Germany, Rep. Les Aspin (D-Wis.) alleged yesterday.

The former White House chief of staff ordered an Army driver in Stuttgart, where Haig recently took command of NATO forces, to fetch the dog from an airport at Frankfurt, Aspin said.

The Pentagon said, however, that the dog's travel arrangements had been handled by an Army officer who had volunteered to take care of the dog.
