SFChroniclian 2 8 1975 Magruder Was Robbed In Jail

Allenwood, Pa.

Jeb Magruder, one of President Nixon's men jailed for his part in the Watergate conspiracy, went back to the federal prison farm here last weekend to collect his belongings—and found they were stolen.

Magruder's locker in the craft shop had been broken into and farm Superintendent Lagry Taylor said an undetermined amount of items were stolen. There was no description of the missing articles.

"Magruder was asked to file a claim," Taylor said.

Allenwood is the federal government's minimum-security facility connected with the nearby Lewisburg Penitentiary.

Magruder, 39, had served seven months of a ten-month to four-year sentence on a charge of obstructing justice.
