Firm Guilty of Illegal Donation

A Baltimore construction company and its two top executives pleaded guilty yesterday to making an illegal \$5000 corporate contribution to Richard Nixon's 1972 re-election campaign.

The firm of Ratrie, Robbins and Schweitzer, Inc., a general construction firm; its president, Harry Ratrie, and the executive vice president, Augustus Robbins III, entered the pleas.

U.S. District Judge George L. Hart fined the corporation \$2500.

Ratrie and Robbins were not fined. They were placed on probation for one month.
