Pay Ziegler

The student government at Michigan State University has withdrawn its \$1250 financial support for a campus appearance by former presidential press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler.

On a 7-to-3 vote Tuesday night, the Associated Students of Michigan State University also called for "mass picketing and a boycott of the speech" if the university goes ahead with plans to bring Ziegler to the campus on February 27.

Ken Beachler, director of the university's lecture-concert series, said the school will honor the \$2500 contract with Ziegler. The university and the student council originally were to split the cost.
