

**Ginzburg Calls for Inquiry
On Arab Role in Campaign**

Ralph Ginzburg, the publisher of Moneysworth, called here yesterday for a Congressional investigation into a 1972 report in the Egyptian newspaper Al Ahrām that said that Arab interests had funnelled \$10-million to \$12-million into President Nixon's re-election campaign in 1972.

Mohammed Hassanein Heykal, one of Egypt's most powerful political figures over the last 20 years. He was relieved of his post as chief editor of Al Ahrām in February, 1974.

In Washington, a spokesman for the Watergate special prosecutor's office said yesterday that the Arab contribution charges were investigated about a year ago. However, the spokesman said, the prosecutors were unable to substantiate the charges one way or the other.
