

Rep. Mottle Calls For Agnew Probe

Congress should investigate reports that former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew has become rich since he resigned his office, Rep. Ronald Mottle (D-Ohio) said yesterday.

He said Agnew and former Attorney General Richard G. Kleindienst should be asked to testify at a congressional hearing about recent reports that they are acting as consultants to investors from Arab countries.

"Agnew is apparently on his way to becoming a multimillionaire by peddling influence and helping Arab investors buy control of American coal mines, real estate and industry," Mottle said in a statement.
