John Dean III, President Nixon's accuser in the Watergate scandals, said last night he has decided to continue his \$175,000 speaking tour because of student response.

Dean told 5000 students at Marshall University he also wants to continue "because maybe we can resolve among ourselves some of the lingering issues."

Dean got a 15-second ovation when he arrived and drew applause repeatedly during the 90-minute talk.

Dean was paid \$3000 for the engagement at Marshall, the third stop on his speaking tour.
