WXPost FEB 7 1975 Nixon's Belongings Moving Out Today

The White House said yesterday that 3½ tons of Richard M. Nixon's personal property will be moved by truck to Andrews Air Force Base in the pre-dawn hours today and flown to the former President's estate in San Clemente, Calif.

A press spokesman said some 50 to 55 crates including Nixon's model elephant collection, gavels, political cartoons and papers dating before and after his years in the White House were included.

A court decision by U.S. District Court Judge Charles Richey last week cleared the way for transferring the memorabilia plus Nixon papers dated before Jan. 20, 1969, and after Aug. 9, 1974, as well as public mail addressed to Nixon after he resigned.
