Justice Marshall In Hospital

Washington

Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall was in Bethesda Naval Hospital yesterday with a minor respiratory infection.

A court spokesman said Marshall, 66, entered the hospital late Tuesday after developing a slight fever.

The spokesman, court information officer Barrett McGurn, said Marshall is resting comfortably.

Justice William O. Douglas, 76, is in satisfactory condition at Walter Reed Army Hospital, recovering from a stroke suffered December 31.

The court reconvenes next Tuesday after a three-week recess. There was no word on whether Marshall will be on the bench at that time.
