Data for the Washington
Post poll on attitudes toWard Watergate was compiled from random telephone interviews conducted Friday night with 351
persons 18 years old and
older. A geographical
weighting system was
used to obtain respondents who appear to be
characteristic of all adult
residents in the area surveyed, which included the
District of Columbia, Alexandria, and Arlington,
Fairfax, Montgomery and
Prince George's Counties.
Polls of this kind cannot
obtain opinions from the
small number of area residents who have no telephones; they do, however,
include the views of persons with unlisted telephone numbers.
