Gurney Trial Moves Slowly

TAMPA, Fla., Feb. 28 (UPI)

—It appeared today that the plodding tempo of jury selection in the bribery-conspiracy trial of former Senator Edward J. Gurney, Republican of Florida, could delay the start of testimony until the middle of next week.

Mr. Gurney, who decided not to seek re-election after becoming the first Senator indicted in office in 50 years, is charged with bribery, conspiracy and making false statements to a grand jury that was probing a political slush fund.
