Mr. Hunt also reportedly denied a report, which has lately sained some currency among mateur assassination investi-ators, that he met Oswald in Mexico City in 1963 while serving as chief of the C.I.A. station

The Warren Commission in-quiry established that Oswald visited Mexico City on Sept. 27, 1963, less than two months be-fore the Kennedy assassination, when he requested permission to visit Cuba from the Cactro Government's embassy there.
